## Keeping Your Kids Safe

At Redeemer Lutheran Church, we want to ensure the safety of your children when they attend VBS. All of our volunteers have gone through our Safe Church training program in compliance with our Safe Church Policy.

## Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures

The doors will open at 8:45 am for you to drop off your child in the church Sanctuary.

On the registration form, you will find a place to list those people who are allowed to pick up your child. Our teachers will only release your child to one of the names you provide. Please make sure it reflects an accurate list. No child will be allowed out into the parking lot without a parent or guardian. The parking lot is busy with activity at the end of the day.

Preschool and Kindergarten Parents: You may pick up your child in the gym beginning at 11:40 am. If you choose, you may take your child to sit in the Sanctuary for the daily closing with the elementary children.

Elementary Parents: You may pick up your child in the sanctuary at 12:00 noon.

## Closing Program

We invite you to attend our VBS closing program on Friday, starting at 11:40 am in the Sanctuary where the children will present and sing many of the songs they have learned throughout the week. The program will last about a half an hour. The program will include both the preschool and elementary children.

## Singing on Sunday, June 25th

We invite you back for our Sunday morning worship service at 10:45, in which all of the children who attended VBS are welcome to sing one of the songs they learned during the week.

### Kingman Mission's Teens Speak Out Program
