Sandy Wilson was the first member of Redeemer Lutheran Church to attend a Synodical teachers' college. Despite her parents' resistance, Sandy walked to Redeemer to worship, was eventually baptized and became a member. She later brought her brother with her, and he also became a baptized member of Redeemer. Sandy attended River Forest and received a teaching position in Michigan. When she was only 24 years old, she was killed in a car accident on her way to church. That's when the Sandy Wilson Memorial Grant was established.
